



- The St. George's Marina has an exclusive deal with Evolutions Health & Fitness Center, offering Day passes for \$10.00 and week passes for \$55.00 (**you must be wearing your St. George's marina wristband to access these rates**)
- Located in St. David's, 4.4km away which is 13 min on one of our courtesy bikes (see additional info below in our Transport section), a 1 hour walk, or 8 min in a taxi. A bus route is also available. See map below and google maps link [HERE](#)




Golf


Bermdua has one of the highest concentrations of golf courses in the world. The closest golf course to the St. George's marina is the [Five forts Golf course](#). The St. George's Marina and Superyacht dock has an exclusive arrangement with the Five Forts Golf course for a discount via our Marina Guest Privilege program. Walking/running


- Maximum usage is up to 3 hours in 1 day - see booking calendar [HERE](#)
- Bikes are limited to St. George's Island and St David's Island (**do not go beyond the airport**)
- Please fill in the waiver [HERE](#)
- The rider will be responsible for any damage to the bike

Biking:

- There are great mountain biking trails at Ferry Point Park, see map and link above for directions. (These trails are NOT suitable for our courtesy bikes).


Mountain bikes can be rented for one of the vendors listed below in the Transportation section.

- Clearwater Beach and Coopers Island Nature Reserve are only a 20 min bike ride away. See map below and Google maps link [HERE](#)




Beaches:

- **Tobacco Bay** is a small and busy beach and is a great favourite with Cruise ship passengers, who tend to visit during the weekdays. It has a nice bar concession and good snorkeling. 


- **St. Catherine's Beach** - the Northern end of this beach is open to the public and very beautiful. You can sit and relax in the shadow of Fort St.Catherine, and

there is also good snorkeling around the point. The Southern end of the Beach is part of the St. Regis Resort. See map below and Google maps link [HERE](#).



- **Drew's Bay** is a very small, but quite often empty, beach with beautiful views. See map below and Google maps link [HERE](#)



Kiteboarding/foiling:

Ask for Mark in the office. He is an avid wing and downwind foiler and he can advise on some good spots depending on wind direction. There are no limitations on kiting or winging in St. George's harbour.

Hamilton:

If you plan to go to Hamilton "**The Big City**" there are plenty of restaurants, bars etc... You have several options.

- Bus up, taxi back. (buses stop running at 11pm) Bus takes about 45min - 1 hour, taxi about 35 mins and is \$30-\$50 dollars depending on time of day, most taxis hold 6 people and charge is metered, rather than per person.
- Taxi both ways
- Moped, if you rent one of these, please be careful - our roads are deceptive and can be tricky after an evening's enjoyment!
- There are four-wheeled electric cars to rent that hold two passengers - check out the info below.

TRANSPORT

Bus: The buses in Bermuda are generally a clean and efficient way to get around. You can purchase tickets and track live buses on the Shorelink app available on Google play shore [HERE](#) or at the Apple store [HERE](#).
